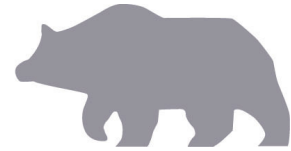

Web registration is not permitted for History of Art, Design and Visual Culture courses numbered 300 or higher. To register, BA Honors, BFA, BDES, MA, MDES and MFA students must meet with a Department advisor to gain approval. All other students must fill out a Request for Registration Form. Web registration is closed to Open Studies students: to register, Open Studies students must fill out a Request for Registration form. The Request for Registration form is available on-line at www.ualberta.ca/ARTDESIGN/html/coursesprograms/RequestForRegistrationForm.pdf or in the Art and Design office located in the Fine Arts Building. Provisional registration only will be granted. To cancel registration students must contact the Department.

All 600-level courses are closed to web registration. Contact the Department for registration assistance.

Priority is given to MA (History of Art, Design and Visual Culture), MFA Graduate students, MDes Graduate students, BA (Honors) students, BFA (Art and Design) students, BDes students, Art and Design Majors, in that order.

History of Art, Design, and Visual Culture courses are offered by the Department of Art and Design in conjunction with 'Art' and 'Design' courses listed under 'ART' and 'DES'.

The Department of Art and Design will include pre and corequisite checking as part of the course restrictions for Fall 2010 and Winter 2011 registration period.

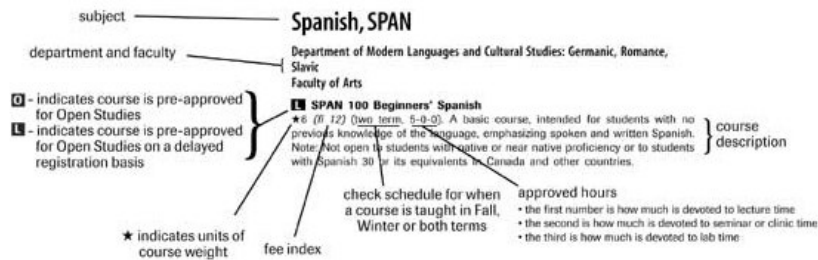
